Class Balls

Due to several incidents involving children being struck and injured by leather balls in school recently, we have decided to ban children bringing in their own balls and have instead purchased 2 sponge balls for each class to use at break and lunchtime. In order to comply with our risk assessment, a child will be selected in each class, each week to be the monitor for each ball and only that child will be permitted to pick-up, carry and touch the ball with their hands. All children in the class will be able to kick the balls and will still be required to wash or sanitise their hands at the end of break and lunch as normal.
