

Decorating a Christmas tree

Toolkit

Draw a plain Christmas tree.
Ask one of your family to read out the instructions to decorate it – you will have to listen carefully. You will need some colour pencils or crayons.

Draw:

- a red bucket around the trunk (bottom) of the tree
- 3 yellow round decorations on the tree
- a star on the top
- a brown teddy bear next to the tree
- 4 chocolates in the middle of the tree
- a square present in front of the tree
- a red triangle decoration between the star and one of the chocolates
- a blue bauble close to the star
- 2 angels on the right of the tree.

Did you get all the things in the right place?
Now make up some instructions for one of your family to draw on another tree.
