Dear Parents/Carers of children in 2 Holly,

I am writing to follow up on my letter dated 21st October 2020 which informed you that Mrs Evans had to work at home for the rest of this term.

At the end of last week, government guidance changed relating to pregnant women – they are no longer considered to be extremely clinically vulnerable in their third trimester now so do not need to work at home, instead they are considered clinically vulnerable so should be in school, being vigilant about social distancing, hand washing etc. to ensure they stay safe.

This means that Mrs Evans has returned to school today. However, since Ms Sylvester has already settled into 2 Holly, and will be with them all year covering Mrs Evans' maternity leave, when this starts in January 2021, we have decided to leave Ms Sylvester in 2 Holly to avoid further changes for the children.

Mrs Evans will instead be covering classes or working with small groups, mainly in Year 2, for the rest of this term.
