Dear parents/carers

Remote learning expectations for Year 1

Each day your child will need to log on to Google Classroom; these log in details are stuck in their yellow reading record books.

Everyday your child will have 3 lessons to complete. Children will be set a daily English and Maths lesson and either Science or a foundation lesson for the afternoon. These lessons will be accessible via Google Classroom and work will need to be uploaded onto Google Classroom for your child's class teacher to view and provide any feedback where necessary.

Two live sessions will take place each day. The first live session will outline the day ahead and will explain what tasks are to be completed. The second live session will include a story and a time to discuss work that has been completed.

1 Pine 9am - 9:20am and 1:45pm - 2pm

1 Willow 9:30am - 9:50am and 2:10pm - 2:25pm

1 Lime 10am - 10:20am and 2:30pm - 2:45pm

When accessing these live sessions please make sure your microphone is mute and stays muted, but please have your camera on. Please be prompt to these sessions. The links to live sessions can be found at the top of the 'stream' when you enter your classroom. These will remain hidden until the teacher is present in the classroom.

Alongside the 3 main lessons set, there will be a daily slide uploaded with a set 1, set 2 or set 3 phonics lesson link. There will be instructions on this slide so you know which lesson to watch and engage with. Parents/carers should also submit a photograph of their child's phonics learning for the class teacher to review.

Each day, on the class stream there will be a sign in sheet. This is so we can monitor the children accessing their learning but to also find out about how your children are feeling being at home and learning this way.

Please make sure you continue to read with your child by reading their school reading book or accessing further books on Oxford Owl. These log ins are again stuck into their yellow reading record.

It is very important you engage with learning at home, to enable your child to maintain attainment levels and avoid slipping behind. It is a good idea to create a learning space for your child to complete their work and try to set up a daily routine so your child is aware of the expectations.

Attached is an optional timetable you may wish to follow. It follows a similar basis to the school day routine, and so may be familiar for your children.

You will still be able to contact your class teacher via the year group email and written feedback will be given to work submitted, along with whole class feedback in the afternoon live session.

We look forward to learning in this exciting new way with you over the next 2 weeks.

| Time          | Subject/Lesson                      | Information   |
|---------------|-------------------------------------|---|
| 9:00 - 9:20   | Live session with the Class Teacher | This session will include information about the lessons planned for your child to complete each day. Please make sure you and your child join with your microphones on mute and if children or adults have any questions then please put these in the chat box. It is important both child and adult are present for this session as your teacher will be explaining the work that needs to be completed and may give tips on how to do this. |
| 9:20 - 10:00  | Maths                               | Children should complete work from Google Classroom. Once work is completed and submitted, children can have the opportunity to play/learn with their own toys, with a link to maths if possible (building blocks, counters, dice games, dominoes, playdough).  |
| 10:00 - 10:30 | Snack and Break                     | Allow your child to have some outside playtime if possible or you could use this time to go for a short walk. It is important children get their exercise and fresh air each day.   |

| 10:30 - 11:30   | English                   | Children should complete work from Google Classroom.<br>Once work is completed and submitted, children can have the opportunity to play/learn with their own toys, with a link to English/fine motor skills if possible. (drawing/colouring, spelling, phonic/word games, practise letters).   |
| 11:30 - 12:30   | Lunch and Play            | Again, try and allow your child to have some outside playtime or a walk.   |
| 12:30 - 1:00  | Phonics                   | Children should complete work from Google Classroom. Adults should submit a photo of their child's phonics learning.   |
| 1:00 - 2:00   | Foundation/Science        | This will either be a History, Science, PSHE, RE or PE lesson.<br>Children should complete work from Google Classroom. Once the work is completed and submitted, children can have the opportunity to play/learn with their own toys.<br>If you wish for this to be linked to the subject then great, however any play/learning time will be beneficial. |
| 2:00 - 2:20   | Live session from Teacher | This will be an end of the day story with your child's class teacher.<br>Your class teacher may also talk through some of the work completed that day.   |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Please note timings of live sessions may differ between classes.</li> <li>● This timetable is optional. However it is closely linked to the timetable of your child's school day, so therefore may help routine and behaviour.</li> <li>● It is very important your children access the online learning, but this can be done at any time during the day.</li> <li>● The live sessions will be very beneficial for you and your child and we encourage all to attend.</li> <li>● Please try and limit screen time during the day, the children will be using the computer for Google Classroom and we would advise children to not access TV/tablet breaks during the day, as they would not at school.</li> </ul> |                           |  |
