JUNIOR CITIZEN EVENT – MONDAY 28TH JUNE 2021

Havering Police, in partnership with Havering Community Safety Partnership, have once again invited our Y6 pupils to the Junior Citizen Event to be held on Monday 28th June at The Territorial Army Building in London Road, Romford from 9.30 a.m to 12 noon.

Junior Citizen was created to educate young people at a crucial point in their education and social development right before they move into Secondary school.

Throughout the morning, the children will be faced with different scenarios related to fire safety, personal safety (linked to alleyways, derelict buildings and bomb threat), public transport, road safety, water safety, knife crime, hate crime and substance abuse.

This event is free and will include transport to and from the event provided by the organisers. The buses/coaches will arrive at the school at 8.30am to collect the children. **Please ensure your child is in school at 8.20am on this day.**

The children will arrive back at school in time for lunch but will need to bring along a named bottle of water as refreshments are not provided. Please also make sure school uniform is worn; 6 Acacia can wear their PE kit.
